

KNOW THE CODE. IT'S YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.

- Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- ♣ You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
- Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- ♣ Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- ♣ Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

Most Important Rules for You on Your First Day

- Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
 - Watch out for your schoolmates! Screaming, "Get out of the way," is not appropriate. Look before you take your turn.
- ♣ People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
 - Telling someone in front of you that they "Cut you off," is not appropriate. They do not have eyes in the back of their head!
- Prior to using the lift, you must have the knowledge and the ability to load, ride and unload safely.
 - Listen carefully to the instructor's directions if your class rides any ski lift. You could be riding a rope tow at Alta or Sundance, a carpet at any of the areas or a chairlift at almost any of the areas. However, before riding a chairlift, you must to be able to stop and in most cases you must also be able to turn!
